

Hey Kids,


Sister Cindy and I know things are a little different right now since we can't go to the church. But, we don't want you to forget that Jesus is always the same.

that keep your attention from Jesus!


We want you to remember that it is just

**What are some ways you can do that?**


# PRAYER

All of these are great people to talk about Jesus with. Maybe you will learn something new about Him or maybe you will teach someone else something new!


Maybe it will even give you the boldness you need to start talking about him everywhere you go!


# MEMORY VERSES AND GUIDED READING

We've included some questions at the end of this packet for y'all to answer as you read it. If you hold on to those and bring them back next time we're together at Kids' Church, there will be a prize for you!




# Joshua and Caleb




- Pay close attention to how even though things looked bad to everyone else, Joshua and Caleb KNEW that God would take care of them!


# Numbers 14
